
Define a clear path to the cloud with a strategic workshop

Generally, over the course of just a few days, we'll collaborate with you to:

- Review how your current processes fit with Infor's unique Implementation Accelerator (IA) processes and approach for cloud upgrades. The IA's preconfigured, yet flexible methods, are based on Infor application suites. They're designed to deliver industry-specific application configurations, an implementation playbook, templates, and tools that provide a framework for implementing industry business processes, migrating data, establishing workflows, and delivering education.
- Identify the key areas of your business that will be involved in the upgrade project, and how they'll be specifically impacted. This typically includes areas such as finance, supply chain, and human resources.
- Identify specific business outcomes that utilize the knowledge of our Infor Value Engineering and Solution Consulting teams.
